




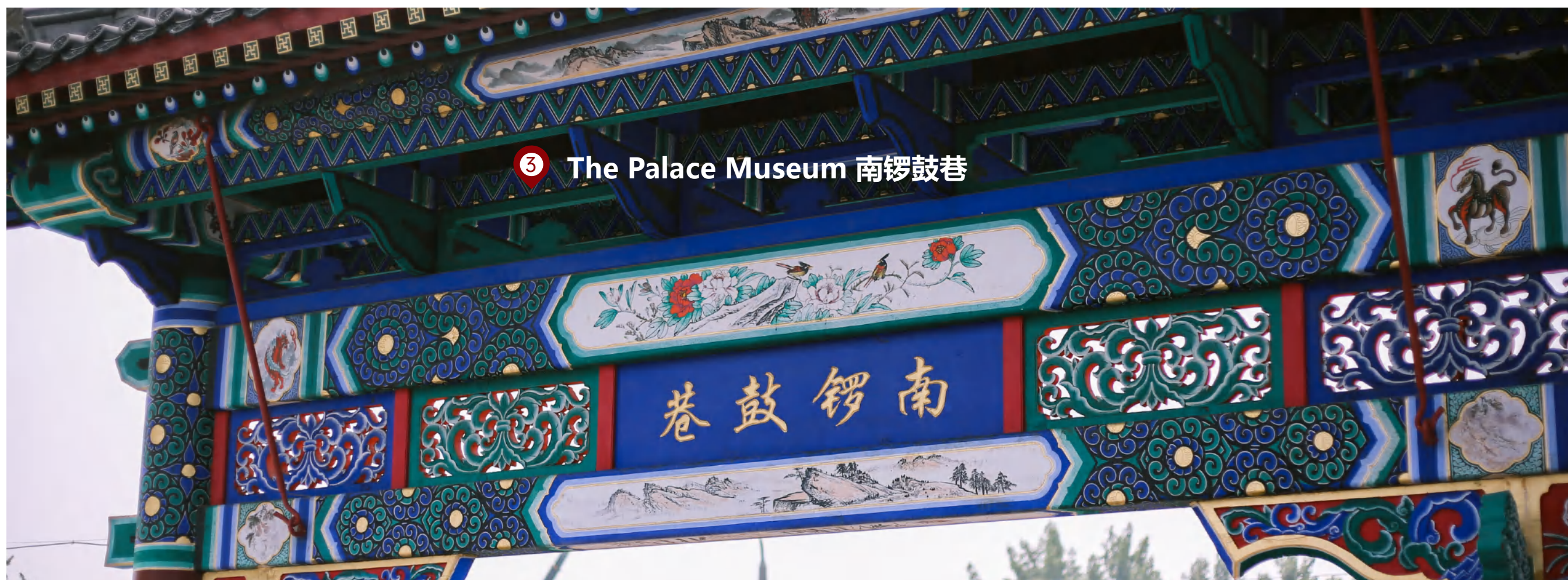

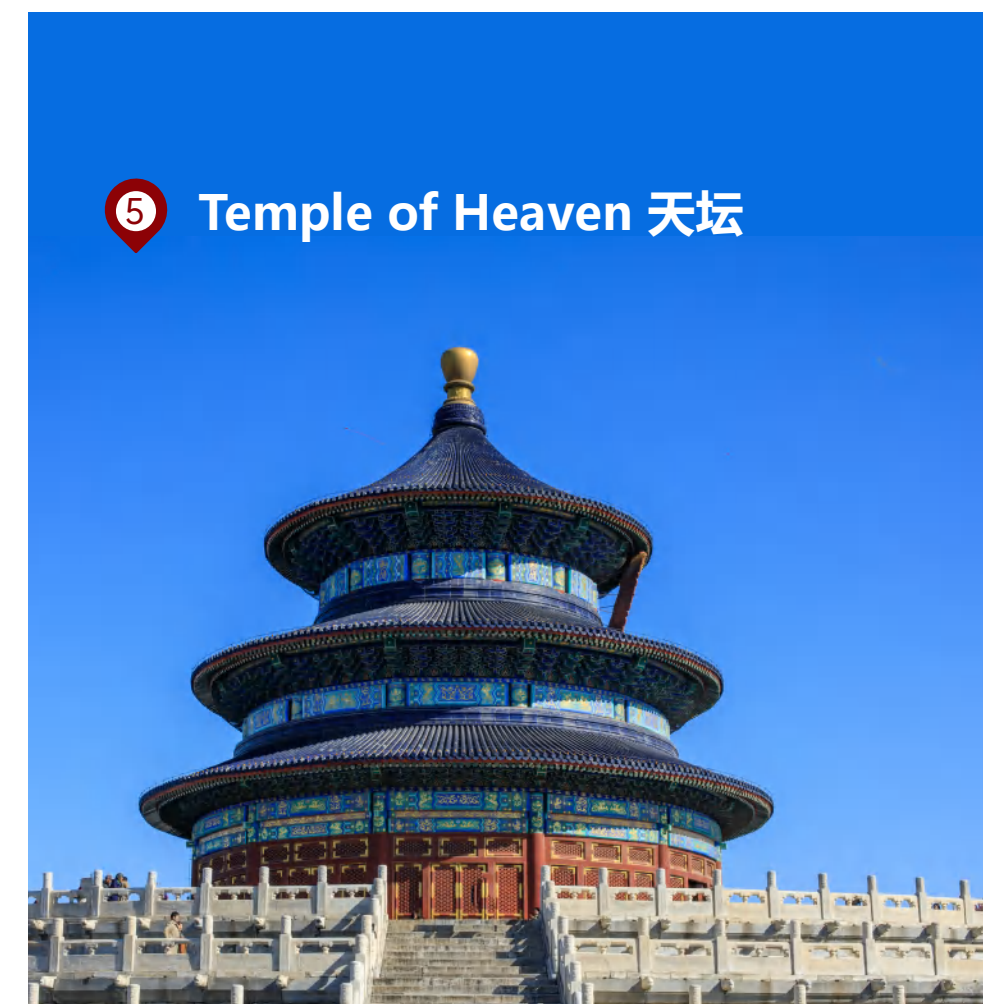

## Sights

### The Palace Museum 故宫博物院



The Forbidden City, also known as the Imperial Palace, was the imperial palace of the Ming and Qing dynasties, and is also the symbol of ancient China. When you are in the majestic and orderly high walls and deep courtyards, you can truly feel its former glory.

08:30-16:30; Last admission: 15:30 (November 1-March 31 of the following year Tuesday-Sunday) Not open to the public (November 1-March 31 of the following year Monday)

## Transportation

- Bus: Take bus No. 1, No. 2, No. 52, No. 120, Sightseeing Line 1, Sightseeing Line 2 and get off at "Tiananmen East" station, then walk about 900 meters to Wumen.
- Subway: Take subway Line 1 and get off at "Tiananmen East" station, walk about 900 meters, and enter the Forbidden City from Wumen. (South Gate of the Palace Museum).
- There is no parking lot in the Forbidden City, and the surrounding public parking lots are also far away, so it is not recommended to drive here.

## ② Badaling Great Wall 八达岭长城



The Badaling Great Wall is known as one of the nine fortresses in the world. Its scenery is majestic, steep, beautiful and verdant. It is the essence of the scenery of the Ming Great Wall. "If you don't go to the Great Wall, you are not a hero." Many Chinese people choose this place as the main choice for climbing the Great Wall. It is divided into two parts: the South Great Wall and the North Great Wall. The South Great Wall has 7 watchtowers and relatively few tourists, while the North Great Wall has 12 watchtowers and is more difficult to climb.

It is a 5A-level scenic spot, listed in the "World Cultural Heritage List" by UNESCO, and its popularity is second only to Tiananmen Square.

07:30-17:00; Ticket sales stop at 16:00 (November 1-March 31 of the following year, Monday-Sunday)

## Transportation

Take bus No. 877/879/Bus Tourist Badaling Line to Badaling Great Wall bus stop and walk about 400 meters to arrive.

## ③ The Palace Museum 南锣鼓巷



Nanluoguxiang is located in the center of Beijing. It is 786 meters long and is the only chess-board-style traditional residential area in my country that has completely preserved the courtyard structure of the Yuan Dynasty Hutong, with the largest scale, highest grade and richest resources. It is also one of Beijing's fashion landmarks.

There are many literary and artistic specialty shops here, as well as a wide variety of snacks. Young people, especially literary and artistic youth, often regard this place as a must-go place for visiting Beijing.

If you want to experience the old Beijing style quietly, you can go to the alleys on both sides to explore. There are many celebrity residences and historical buildings that will definitely make your trip worthwhile.

### Transportation

- Bus: You can take bus No. 118, No. 13, No. 3, No. 4, Night No. 2, Night No. 3, or Sightseeing No. 3 to Nanluoguxiang Station, which is within walking distance.
- Subway: You can take subway Line 6 or Line 8 to Nanluoguxiang Station, which is within walking distance.



The Summer Palace is located in the western suburbs of Beijing. It is the first of China's classical gardens and was listed in the World Heritage List on December 2, 1998.

It is the largest and most complete existing royal garden in my country. It has extremely elegant scenery and many rare cultural relics. It is known as the "Royal Garden Museum".

### Transportation

- Bus: You can take bus No. 118, No. 13, No. 3, No. 4, Night No. 2, Night No. 3, or Sightseeing No. 3 to Nanluoguxiang Station, which is within walking distance.
- Subway: You can take subway Line 6 or Line 8 to Nanluoguxiang Station, which is within walking distance .



### ⑤ Bird's Nest 鸟巢



Located in the southern part of the central area of Beijing Olympic Park, it covers an area of 204,000 square meters and can accommodate more than 90,000 spectators. It was completed on June 28, 2008.

The main body is a "bird's nest" shape woven by a series of steel trusses around the bowl-shaped seating area. The structure is novel and unique, with strong shock and visual impact, fully reflecting the beauty of natural harmony.

10:00-18:00 (November 1st to March 15th of the following year, Monday to Sunday)

#### Transportation

Take bus No. 82, 419, 538, Sightseeing Line 3, or Night Line 34 to Beichen East Road (bus stop), then walk about 600 meters to the destination.

### ⑥ Tiananmen Square 天安门



Tiananmen Square is located in the center of Beijing. It is 880 meters long from north to south and 500 meters wide from east to west. It covers an area of 440,000 square meters and can accommodate 1 million people for grand rallies.

In the square, along the central axis of Beijing, from north to south, there stand the national flagpole, the Monument to the People's Heroes, the Chairman Mao Memorial Hall and the Zhengyangmen Tower.

#### Opening hours

5:00-22:00 (January 1st - December 31st, Monday to Sunday)

#### Transportation

● Bus: ① Take bus line 2/120/Sightseeing 2 to Tiananmen Square West Bus Station, and walk about 168 meters to arrive.

② Take bus line 2/5/5 Sectional/120/Sightseeing 2 to Tiananmen Square East Bus Station, and walk about 243 meters to arrive.

● Subway: Take Metro Line 1 and get off at Tiananmen East or Tiananmen West.

## ⑤ Temple of Heaven 天坛



The Temple of Heaven is a famous ancient building in China. It is a special altar for emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties to offer sacrifices to heaven, pray for rain and a good harvest. The altar is round in the north and square in the south, implying "the sky is round and the earth is square". The whole Temple of Heaven is divided into two parts: the inner altar and the outer altar. Famous buildings such as the Hall of Prayer for Good Harvests and the Echo Wall are all located in the inner altar.

### Transportation

#### ● Bus:

- ① South Gate of the Temple of Heaven: Take Bus No. 53, 62, 122, 141 to get off at South Gate of the Temple of Heaven Station;
- ② West Gate of the Temple of Heaven: Take Bus No. 120, 141, 2, 36, 53 to get off at West Gate of the Temple of Heaven Station;
- ③ North Gate of the Temple of Heaven: Take Bus No. 106, 110, 34, 35, 36 to get off at North Gate of the Temple of Heaven Station;
- ④ East Gate of the Temple of Heaven: Take Bus No. 116, 128, 39, 41, 43, 6 to get off at Fahua Temple Station.

#### ● Subway:

- ① Take Subway Line 5 to East Gate of the Temple of Heaven Station, Exit A
- ② Take Subway Line 8 to Tianqiao Station, Exit C

## Eating

As the capital of China, Beijing has a rich food culture that combines imperial cuisine, local snacks and ethnic minority flavors. In this city where ancient and modern are intertwined, food is not only a feast for the taste buds, but also a heritage of culture and history.

### ◆ Peking Duck 北京烤鸭

Roast duck is a famous Beijing dish that is famous all over the world. Only high-quality Beijing ducks are used and roasted with wood with natural fragrance. The duck skin is translucent, the meat is fat but not greasy, and the outside is crispy and the inside is tender. It is unforgettable and leaves a lingering fragrance in your mouth.





### ◆ Zha Jiang Mian 炸酱面

Noodles with soybean paste is a traditional Beijing noodle dish, mainly made of hand-rolled noodles and soybean paste (fried with yellow bean paste and minced meat), with vegetables such as cucumber shreds and bean sprouts. The taste is salty and rich, and the noodles are chewy.



### ◆ Hotpot 涮羊肉

Shabu-shabu mutton is a classic winter delicacy in Beijing. It is made from high-quality mutton slices, boiled in clear or spicy soup, and dipped in sesame paste, chives and other condiments. It has a fresh and tender taste, is warming and delicious.



### ◆ Donkey Roll 驴打滚

Dagun is a traditional Beijing dessert made from glutinous rice dough wrapped with red bean paste and rolled in soybean powder on the outside. It has a soft, sweet taste and its name comes from the rolling action during its production process.



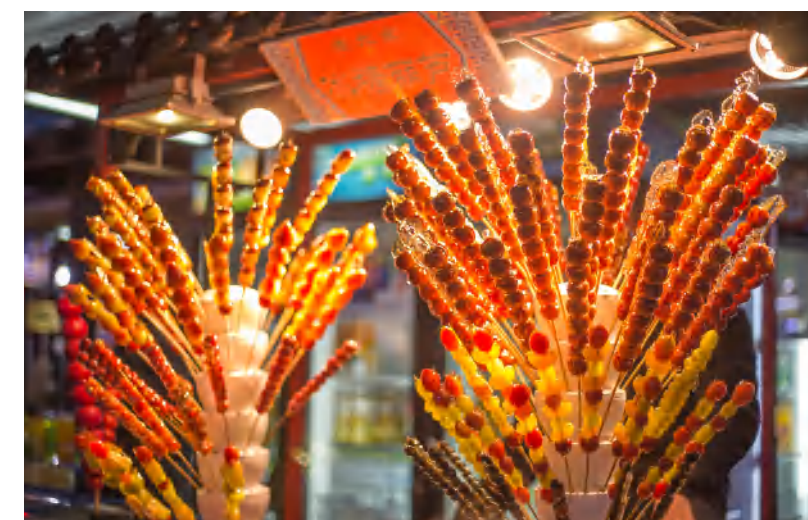
### ◆ Sheep Ribs 羊蝎子

A pot of fragrant lamb ribs, with a mellow soup base, a blend of spices and the essence of bone marrow, exuding an enticing aroma.



### ◆ Candied Haws 糖葫芦

Tanghulu is a street snack in Beijing. It is made of hawthorns and coated with syrup. After cooling, it forms a crispy and sweet candy shell, which is sweet and sour.





### ◆ Fried sausage 炸灌肠

The fried sausage is crispy on the outside and tender on the inside, with a strong garlic flavor, giving you a taste of old Beijing.



### ◆ Beijing-style shredded pork 京酱肉丝

The sauce is rich and the shredded meat is tender and smooth, paired with shredded green onions rolled into the pancake. Every bite is authentic Beijing flavor, delicious and satisfying.
